

Transitioning from External Label Supply to Internal Label Printing

The transition from ordering pre-printed labels to producing labels in-house and on-demand may seem difficult at first, but once you outline the cost savings plus operational savings, the decision becomes very clear with the transition being seamless. The AUTONOMY digital label printer is very simple to operate and maintain. Your label artwork and variable data are printed and inspected at the same time, linking each to your network or database, reducing the risk of printing the wrong label with the wrong variable data. The AUTONOMY can also connect to your serialization server and database for printing, inspecting, and batch reporting.
